



Instructions for Ghost and Bat

Items you are given for the **Ghost**: Tissue Paper, Button, Paper Towel, String, Orange Ribbon, and Black Paper

Items you are given for the **Bat**: Clothes Pin, 2 Googly Eyes, Red Circle, and Black Paper

Items you will need for BOTH crafts: Glue and Scissors, additionally for the Ghost craft, a sharpened pencil

Ghost Instructions

Step 1: Remove the tissue from the package and make a bag and open it up. Then fold the tissue in half and then in half again, so it is basically a square shape. On the two edges that are **NOT** the folded edges, use your scissors to cut wiggly lines so that when you open the whole thing up you will basically have a wiggly circle.

Step 2: Unfold the tissue you just cut, and at the very center (where the fold lines meet), make a small hole with a sharpened pencil. (This is where your hanger will come out.) Make sure you keep the hole only large enough for the string that you will be knotting in step 3....make sure it is small enough so that the button will NOT come through.

Step 3: Thread your piece of string through the holes of the button and then tie the string ends together. Push the knot through the hole you made in step 2 and pull it through so the button is flush with the tissue paper.

Step 4: Crumple your paper towel into a round shape (the ghost's head), center the paper towel ball over the button and gather the tissue paper around the ball of paper towel.

Step 4: Tie the orange ribbon at the base of the ghost's head. You can curl it up, or leave it dangly.

Step 5: Cut out eyes and a mouth for your ghost and glue the pieces onto your ghost head. Let it dry before you hang it up. You are finished creating your ghost!

Bat Instructions

Step 1: Fold your black paper in half and at the fold, cut one half of the bat wings....when you unfold it you will have identical wings with a fold down the middle. **(SAVE the scrap black paper to make the bat's body and ears.)**

Step 2: Put some glue down one side of the clothes pin, and using some of the scrap of black paper, lay it down over the glue so the clothes pin is completely covered. Let it dry. Once it is dry, trim off the paper that hangs over the edges.

Step 3: Glue the wings you made in step 1 onto the back of the bat (the side that you DID NOT just cover with black paper). Let the wings dry.

Step 4: Glue the red circle onto your bat for the head, and add googly eyes and ears (you can cut these from more of the black paper scrap). Let this dry as well.

Step 5: Once your crafts are completely dry, you can decorate your room, house, locker.....whatever!
