

Turkey Leaf Craft

Things you are given: Brown paper, orange paper, red paper, 1 strip of gold paper, 2 googly eyes, and 3 leaves

Things you will need: Scissors, glue & a pencil

Step 1: Draw a large 8 on the brown construction paper (measuring 4-5 inches in height). Cut around the outside of the figure you just drew. This is the turkey's body.

Step 2: Draw a triangle (for the beak) and two feet out of the orange paper, and then cut them out. Draw a long teardrop on red paper and cut it out (for the wattle).

Step 3: Glue both googly eyes, the nose and the wattle onto the head of the turkey. Glue the feet to the bottom of the turkey's body. Let dry and then turn the turkey over.

Step 4: Glue the leaves on the back of the turkey (this may require a good amount of glue). While the leaves are drying, fold the gold paper strip in half (this is the stand). Glue one side to the bottom back of the turkey. Let the leaves and stand dry completely before standing your turkey upright.

Note: If your turkey doesn't stand straight, make sure the gold paper is not crooked in the back. If so, trim accordingly.
