

Upcycled Tic-Tac-Toe Game

Items you will need:

- empty cereal box, or other piece of cardboard, cut into a square, 7 inches by 7 inches
- white glue
- construction paper (3 different colors)
- 10 bottle caps
- marker
- scissors
- ruler

Step 1: Take one of the colors of construction paper and cut it to fit over the 7" x 7" piece of cardboard. Glue this square of construction paper onto the cardboard. Let it dry.

Step 2: With your marker, draw a tic-tac-toe grid onto the construction paper you just glued down (3 columns by 3 rows, so you end up with 9 equal squares)

Step 3: From another color of construction paper, cut five circles. They should fit inside the bottle caps. Glue them in place into the bottle caps. Repeat this process with the final color of construction paper and the remaining bottle caps. You will end up with 10 playing pieces, 5 of each color.

Step 4: Your tic-tac-toe game is now ready to use. Have fun!
