

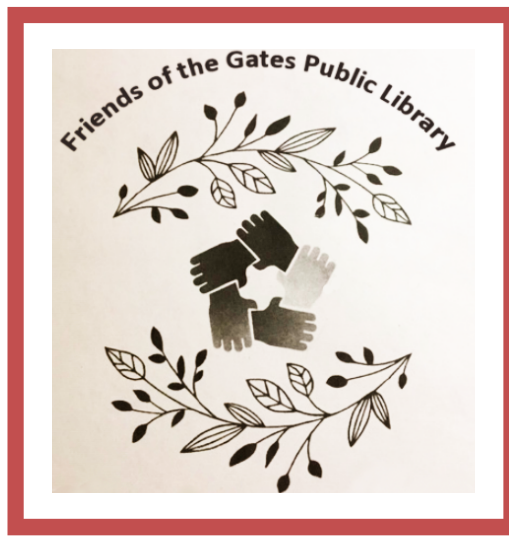
WHO ARE THE FRIENDS OF THE GATES PUBLIC LIBRARY?
